**Hearing of the Public-**Members of the fire dept were present as well as the Fire Chief and Frank Force, Township Supervisor.

**Old Business-**

1. Fire station project- Steve Switzer presented drawings and site plan. The dept reviewed the plans and made some changes. Colors were also chosen for the brick, siding and metal and windows. The landscaping was discussed and it was decided that the Dept. would do the landscaping; Kurt offered to do some final grade on the lawn area so it will be ready for seed. Signage for the building was also discussed as well as furniture for the offices. May 4 the Planning Commission will review the plans for the building project.
2. Homeland Security Program (FEMA)- no updates.

**New Business-**

1. Speed Limit on Dream Isle- Shari brought to the attention of the FASC that the speed limit sign on Dream Isle is posted 30mph just yards from Lessiter Ave. and is not being enforced by the high volume of traffic that the road holds now that there is increased housing on the street and the increased boat traffic for the season. There are many more children playing near the street and concerned that people that are not abiding by the posted speed limit may cause an accident. Shari would like to see another sign posted and public awareness of the increased children on the street. Frank offered to call the Road commission.
